3. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM

- a. Candidates are advised to read and understand the application and the Terms and conditions thoroughly before filling the application form.
- b. Down Loaded Application Forms
Prospectus and application Forms can be downloaded from the Website.
Down loaded application forms will not have a serial number. Once the duly filled application along with the Demand Draft for the amount involved is received in the Office, a serial number is given and the same will be communicated to the candidate.
Those who are desirous of getting the hard copy of the Prospectus by post should send the DD for Rs. 660/-. Those who are not particular in getting a hard copy need send the DD only for Rs. 600/-
- c. Form must be filled in candidate's own handwriting, by using CAPITAL LETTERS.
- d. Keep a photocopy of the filled application for future reference. This is particularly required in case you need a duplicate hall ticket.
- e. Any discrepancy in the statements or submission of incomplete or incorrectly filled forms or unclear photographs will lead to rejection of application.
- f. Photograph: Paste your recent passport size (only face close up) colour photographs (Photo should contain person's name and date photographed) in three places (Photographs taken on or after 1.1.2009 only should be pasted) One at the space provided at the top right portion of the application form; second one on the hall ticket and the third one on the attendance sheet. Unclear and defaced photographs may lead to rejection of the application.

- g. **Name of Applicant :** Name in CAPITAL LETTERS, as it appears in your marks card of the qualifying examination or as in the 10th standard /SSLC mark list. Leave one blank box between names.
- h. **Date of Birth :** Enter the date, month and year of birth as recorded in the 10th standard School Leaving Certificate.
- i. **Qualifying examination :** Candidates whose results of the qualifying examination are not available could also write the Entrance Examination subject to their producing the mark list / certificate of the qualifying examination at least at the time of admission. No separate communication will be issued for the marks list.
- j. Write the full name in the hall ticket and attendance sheet. The name should be as it appears in the application. Write the complete postal address and PIN Number in the hall ticket.
- k. Application should be accompanied by copies of B.Sc Degree Mark List and passing certificates.

4. ISSUE OF HALL TICKET

Hall Tickets will be sent by post. For this purpose, an envelope is provided with the Application. Candidates should write their correct address with pin code and telephone number on the same, affix postal stamp of appropriate value (**Rs. 5/- for ordinary post**) and return it along with completed application.

If you do not receive the Hall Ticket by July 1, 2009, candidates will have to contact the Admission Co-ordinator, Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi (Telephone No: 0484-285 8374 or 285 5651) for a duplicate Hall Ticket. Candidate has to be personally present himself / herself for collection of duplicate Hall ticket and are required to submit the following:

- a. A photocopy of the duly filled up application form.
- b. Recent Passport size colour photographs (**face close up** with name and date photographed) two numbers.
- c. Receipt issued by the post office towards Speed post or Registered post or the receipt issued by the Courier agency to confirm despatch of your original application to AMRITA School.
- d. Submit an undertaking the format of which will be supplied by University Office, Kochi.

5. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Candidates will be allowed to enter the examination hall 15 minutes before commencement of the examination.

Candidates will not be allowed to enter the examination hall after 30 minutes from the commencement of the examination and will not be permitted to leave the examination hall till the scheduled end of the examination except in case of an emergency.

Once the candidate leaves the hall (even if only to answer a call of nature) he/ she will not be allowed to re-enter the examination hall.

Candidates should hand over the answer sheet and the question paper to the Invigilator before leaving the examination hall. **If the question paper is not returned**, the answer sheet will not be evaluated

Candidates must bring their own Pen, HB pencil, sharpener and eraser.

Candidates are not allowed to bring any books, notes, mobile phone, paging device, slide rules, Clark table, calculator, laptop or any other electronic gadgets to the examination hall.

If any one happens to bring any of these items the same should be deposited outside the examination hall solely at the risk of the candidate.

Candidates are not allowed to have any conversation or gesticulation or disturbance in the exam hall. Such acts of behaviour could lead to the candidate being debarred and will be sent out of the examination hall.

During the examination, the invigilator will check the Hall Tickets to satisfy the identity of the candidate and in his/her presence candidate must sign

a. The attendance card (Counterfoil of the Hall Ticket)

b. Roomwise attendance sheet

Candidates must make their own arrangements of stay for the purpose of Entrance Examination. If candidate lives far from the Exam Centre, he/she is advised to reach the city on the previous day.

6. PUBLICATION OF RESULTS

Results of entrance examination will be published on the same day. Candidates qualified for interview must appear for the same which is scheduled to take place from 2 p.m on 05-07-2009.

7. MODE OF SELECTION

a. Depending on the rank a candidate secures in the Written Test as well as in the interview Principal, Amrita School Of Medicine and Chairman-Admissions will allot an appropriate subject and Chairman's decision will be final & binding .

b. Selected Candidates will be informed their dates of admission / payment of fees.

8. COUNSELING & ADMISSION

(a) Selected candidates can take admission from 9th July to 11th July 2009.

(b) No separate call letters will be sent. Candidates called for admission should report to the Chairman, Admissions.

(c) While reporting for admissions, the candidate should be accompanied at least by one of the parents and should produce the following documents in original along with two additional sets of photocopies.

i. Degree marks list for M.Sc & PG Diploma and Plus two marklist for B.Sc MRT.

ii. Degree certificate for M.SC & PG Diploma and plus two pass certificate for B.SC MRT.

iii. A document to prove the date of birth.

iv. Transfer certificate from the Institution last attended.

v. Migration Certificate from the university/Board from where the candidate passed his/ her Plus two / Degree.

vi. Passport size face close-up colour photographs – 4 Nos.

vii. Demand draft for the amount which will be intimated to the candidate favouring AMRITA VISHWA VIDYAPEETHAM payable at Kochi.

9. VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS

All admissions are subject to verification of the original certificates and documents of the candidates. The decision of the Chairman, Admissions(Medical), Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham regarding the eligibility of any applicant shall be final.

10. PAYMENT OF FEES

Full fees for the FIRST YEAR will have to be paid at the time of admission. Fees for the remaining years will have to be paid in July every year or on dates announced by the University.

11. CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

For Candidates opting to discontinue the study within a period of one week from the date of commencement, 75% of the Tuition fees will be refunded. After this period but before expiry of one month from the date of commencement of classes if one discontinues the studies, 50 % of the tuition fees will be refunded. After one month period if one opts to discontinue, no refund of tuition fees will be made. Besides, a suitable compensation as decided by the Principal, Amrita School of Medicine, will also have to be paid. Unutilized portion of the other fees and caution money will be refunded after recoveries of dues if any.

Candidates shall be deemed to have withdrawn from the course if she or he remains absent for more than 30 days from the date of commencement.

12. ACCOMMODATION

For girl students accommodation will be provided subject to availability on payment basis.

13. DISCIPLINE

The colleges, hospitals and hostels are parts of Mata Amritanadamayi Math, the parent trust and therefore, rules and regulations as prescribed should be strictly followed.

- a. Only Vegetarian food will be served in the Hostel.
- b. Students are not allowed to keep two-wheelers and cars in the campus.
- c. Use of mobile phones, ipods, videos, cameras, laptops and all such electronic gadgets inside the campus is prohibited.
- e. Smoking and alcoholic drinks are totally prohibited.
- f. There will be a mandatory dress code for all students throughout the course.
- g. There will be regular value oriented classes/discussions in the campus. Students are advised to participate in these programmes. This is an Institution meant for higher learning and the objective is not only to impart education but also to build the character of the students and transform them into better human beings.
- h. A student hand book will be issued at the time of admission which will contain all the rules and regulations in detail. The students shall strictly abide by them.
- i. Students are expected to observe absolute discipline in their conduct during the entire period they spend in the Institution. Failure to observe absolute discipline will invite appropriate action.
- j. Ragging is a criminal offence and is prohibited by law of the land. If any student is found to have involved or indulged in any incident of ragging he/she will be summarily expelled from the institution . Such student will be liable to pay to the institution all the loss that the institution may have to suffer on account of such expulsion. Decision of the principal with regard to expulsion , loss and recovery will be final and binding on the student. Where the circum-

stances warrant, the principal may report incidences of ragging to the police also for appropriate action.

Mere presence at the scene of ragging amounts to abetment of Ragging and is liable for punishment.

14. MEDICAL INSURANCE

All students will be covered under group medical insurance scheme, within stipulated limits.

15. ATTENDANCE

A minimum of 80% Physical presence in a subject including attendance in non lecture teaching is compulsory for appearing for the University examinations.

16. DRESS CODE

There will be a mandatory dress code for all students throughout the course. This has to be very strictly followed. Institution will supply following number of uniforms.

Uniform for males : 3 Pairs of Pants & Shirts + 2 White Coats

For females: 2 Pairs of Churidar sets (with shawl) + 2 White Coats + 1 Saree.

Students of Dialysis Therapy, CVT, CPT & AICT would need to wear scrub suits also. Institution will provide this on payment.

17. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

In case of any dispute in the interpretation of any of the conditions included in this booklet or in any other matter related to admission to MSc, PG Diploma and BSc MRT to any Institution located within the Health Science Campus of Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences at Kochi, decision of the Medical Director will be final and binding.

18. JURISDICTION

Courts situated in Kochi, Kerala only will have jurisdiction over disputes if any arising on the matter of applications and or admission to the courses covered under this Prospectus.
